Review of Operations

Solid Progress - Company Positioned for Sector Rebound

Mantle's activities for the half year ended December 2008 were dominated by field activity at four priority areas and response to the Global Financial Crisis:

Mt Mulligan Coal & Coal Bed Methane Project:

After consolidating ownership to 100%, the company made substantial headway in negotiating an access agreement with the Traditional Custodians of Mt. Mulligan. The approach being taken has seen agreement in principal reached and a full draft Indigenous Land Use Agreement (ILUA) progressed along with preliminary planning for an Authorization (signing) ceremony. Preparation work continued on development of a detailed, regional and project scale digital model from geological and geophysical databases and historic exploration results.

Barkly Phosphate Project:

At the company's phosphate tenements in the Northern Territory a desktop study was undertaken and priority targets generated. Initial field reconnaissance was completed and a review of potential large scale targets carried out to determine a suitable future exploration program. Evaluation of recently acquired geological databases and historic exploration reports was ongoing, with a number of prior drill intercepts showing mineralized grades up to 11% P_2O_5 from 35m depth. We also received a Notice of Proposed Grant of ELA 27035, which is contiguous with EL 26019.

Granite Castle & Charters Towers Gold Projects:

At the Granite Castle gold project a review of all rock chip, soil sample and historical drill results confirmed well in excess of 2.5 kilometres of partially tested, mineralized shears, available for drill testing. This is significant given the mineralization making up the JORC resource base is contained in only 600 metres of a single shear. At the Charters Towers gold project, scout drilling was completed on the Gromac prospect and soils sampling and geological mapping was completed at various other prospect locations.

Haunted Stream Gold Project:

At the Haunted Stream gold prospect, results from diamond drilling were received. Holes were up to eight kilometres apart and less than 100 metres deep and gave indication of significant gold in the system. We were notified that MLA 5505 was Awarded Priority and a soils sampling and ground magnetics survey was instigated following on from completion of a similar programme at the Mt Baldhead gold prospect.

Response to the Global Financial Crisis:

All field work was incrementally shut down for the duration of the northern wet season and until the global financial situation improves. All contract staff were released with minimum geological staff retained to maintain tenements in good standing, develop exploration programmes and review emerging opportunity. A number of potential Farm-out and Equity JV opportunities were evaluated in order to facilitate future activity on priority projects whilst conserving cash reserves.

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NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE HALF-YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2008

NOTE 1: BASIS OF PREPARATION

The half-year consolidated financial statements are a general purpose financial report prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Corporations Act 2001, Australian Accounting Standard AASB 134: Interim Financial Reporting, Australian Accounting Interpretations and other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board.

It is recommended that this financial report be read in conjunction with the annual financial report for the year ended 30 June 2008 and any public announcements made by Mantle Mining Corporation Limited Public Limited and its controlled entities during the half-year in accordance with continuous disclosure requirements arising under the Corporations Act 2001.

The accounting policies have been consistently applied by the entities in the consolidated group and are consistent with those in the June 2008 financial report.

The half-year report does not include full disclosures of the type normally included in an annual financial report.

Reporting Basis and Conventions

The half-year report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs modified by the revaluation of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities for which the fair value basis of accounting has been applied.

NOTE 2: ACQUISITION AND DISPOSAL OF SUBSIDIARIES AND RESTRUCTURING

On 13th August 2008 the parent entity acquired 100% of Mt Mulligan Coal Pty Ltd. The purchase price was satisfied by the issue of 631,579 shares valued at 38c per share and 1,350,000 options.
